Skills Bootcamps 2023 - 2024



What are Skills Bootcamps?

As part of the Lifetime Skills Guarantee, the Government have committed investment into a series of Skills Bootcamps.

Skills Bootcamps offer free, flexible courses of up to 16 weeks. They are available for adults aged 19 or over who are either in work or recently unemployed and live in England.

They give people the opportunity to build up sectorspecific skills and fast-track to an interview with a local employer.

The National Skills Fund will fund both 70%, for large enterprises and 90% for SME's, of the cost of upskilling the existing workforce across a variety of sectors.

Skills Bootcamps are free to the learner and any contributions made towards any Skills Bootcamp are made by the employer.



What is the Department for Education Funding?

The DfE are funding Skills Bootcamps.

Who are Bootcamps for?

Skills Bootcamps are short and flexible training programmes which are subsidised by the Department for Education, which can last up to 16 weeks, based on employer and sector in-demand skills needs.

The Skills Bootcamps are aimed at adults, aged 19+, who are in full-time/ part-time employment, unemployed or self-employed – and designed to meet the needs of employers and the wider economy with targeted training programmes to meet in-demand vacancies.

Skills Bootcamp Eligibility

Question	Answer
What is an SME?	Any company with fewer than 250 employees and has an annual turnover of less than £50 million.
What is a Large Employer?	Any company with 250+ employees and has an annual turnover of more than £50 million.
What is the minimum age to be eligible for a Skills Bootcamp?	19+. Learners must be 19+ before 31st August of that funding year.
Can any learner access a Skills Bootcamp?	No. Learners must have a right to work in the UK and must have been living in the UK for at least 3 years.
Can a learner complete more than one Skills Bootcamp per funding year?	No. A learner can only complete one Skills Bootcamp per funding year. Each funding year runs from 1st April - 31st March.
Can a learner live outside of England and access the funding?	Learners must live in England, and you should not actively recruit learners who live or work outside of England. If there is a situation where a learner lives in Scotland or Wales, please contact us and we will advise on the next steps.
